




Sakia.org

 - **Miscellaneous services** - e.g. newsletter, Sakia, ora e-publish, and more.



Objective

The main objective of Sakia.org is to build capacity in science and engineering by means of information-sharing through publicly accessible quality information, free on-line applications and professional communications and discussions in the area of 'land and water'.

Description

Most knowledge is traditionally published and stored in journals or books and, while most of these are nowadays produced electronically or have at least been converted into electronic format, they still remain unavailable to a large number of professionals as access restrictions by publishers apply. In order to provide open access to different types of good quality knowledge and discussions, Sakia.org has been designed to provide the necessary framework and facilities allowing to create, publish, print and reprint information of technical and scientific significance. Sakia.org is independent and open and not bound to specific organisations, institutions, publishers or regions. Services currently provided through Sakia.org are:

- VL Irrigation & Hydrology

The VL Irrigation & Hydrology is an index and repository of quality screened technical information available at Sakia.org. On-line information is supplemented with references to valuable external sources. The VL has been operational since 1995.


