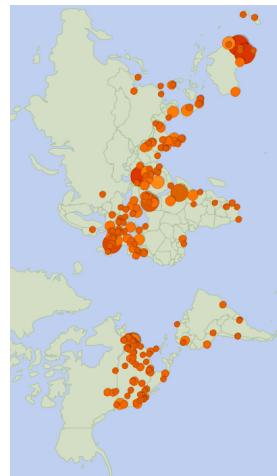


Sakia.org

Sakia.org is a widely used free and independent information and communication service in the area of 'land and water'. It is well established since 1994/95 and frequently visited by professionals from the national and international arena.



Its objective is to build capacity in science and engineering by means of information-sharing through publicly accessible quality information, free on-line applications and professional communications and discussions.

Technically it is placed in the wider water sector with the main focus on agricultural water management, irrigation, drainage, hydrology and related fields.

The 'e-Journal of Land Water' (ISSN 1832-5149) is an open access and peer reviewed, international scientific journal for research and developments in land and water. It is published by [Sakia.org e-publish/](http://www.sakia.org/ejlw/).

Objective

The Objective of the e-Journal of Land and Water (eJLW) is to publish scientific papers of international significance covering basic, applied and strategic research in the area of land and water. The journal is being published under the general principles of open access, which means the articles published in it will be available on-line free of charge to the end user.

Description

Technically the e-Journal of Land and Water is focused on the integration of the various aspects of land and water management and conservation at a range of scales. While the journal provides an ideal framework for research topics of multidisciplinary nature, it equally allows to cover specific components from the wider land and water arena:

- Irrigation science, technology and management;
- Drainage and land reclamation;
- Catchment management;

- Soil and water conservation;
- Community, social and economic aspects of land and water;
- Sustainability issues;
- Policy and planning.


Submission and review

Manuscripts are only accepted when submitted electronically through the authors gateway at the eJLW website. Detailed information and instruction to authors are found on-line.

Submitted manuscripts are peer reviewed by independent editors, scientist and experts of proven technical and scientific expertise. All manuscripts are handled by the Editor-in-Chief.

Sakia.org open access licence

"By accepting the manuscript, Sakia.org e-publish acquires the unrestricted copyright on the manuscript. It protects the authors' rights while providing free and unimpeded access to the full text source. The 'Sakia.org Open Access License' grants permission to individual users to freely access, download, print, extract, archive, crawl, index and distribute articles for personal use only. The distribution of small numbers of copies are allowed for academic, scientific or educational purposes. This also includes the passing on of copies to colleagues as long as no mass distribution is being performed and/or a commercial benefit is sought or fees are charged. All the work and authors have to be credited and cited appropriately and the source to be named. No mass distribution, selling or re-packaging of its paper or electronic form is allowed.
